As part of its ongoing research grant awarded by the International Visegrad Fund, Anglo-American University is announcing a call for papers for participation in the international Colloquium "Comparing Responses to the COVID-19 Pandemic: Alternative Leadership Styles in the V4".

The goal of the Colloquium is to share the results, experience, and feedback of the project team with a large expert and interested audience, to provide a forum for exchange of views, and stimulate discussion. The project team members will present the results of their research, the latest experience with the monitored issues and their ideas for future work. The presentations of registered papers and discussion of participants will open further perspectives and raise questions for consideration and examination. The Colloquium will be recorded, and the recording and other materials from the Colloquium will be published on the project's website.

Proposed papers should be focused on the Visegrad 4 states and discuss aspects relevant to one or more state's Covid response and/or crisis leadership style. Decisions on acceptance will be emailed by October 31, 2022.
